Isabelle Rozot

Isabelle was born in Nancy, France in 1962. She studied painting at the Ecole des Arts Decoratifs in Strasbourg and then came to London to study at Chelsea School of Art. Isabelle lives and paints in Paris, in a former diamond-cutter's workshop built from remnants of the Eiffel Tower, surrounded by stuffed spiders and rickety Napoleonic furniture. Antiques, curiosity shops, social life and late 19th century literature provide the inspiration for her work. Like the characters in a Scott Fitzgerald novel the languid inhabitants of her paintings subtly convey the shadow side of an idle existence.
